DR. CONGER'S STORY:

My parents came to Oklahoma at the opening of the Cherokee Strip, from Kansas.

"Grand father-Robert M. Conger was one of the delegates to first legislative convention at Guthrie, Later on when Okla(homa) was admitted to the Union, he was one of the three delegates to present the 47th star to the union Flag at Phelidelphia [sic.]"
