THE OLD WETUMKA MISSION SCHOOL.

The Old Wetumka Mission School was built in 1881. There is still a large apple orchard there. The building was two stories with a basement; one room was used for the doctor's office and one room for a hospital. The basement was used to store apples for the winter.

The Old Mission building was torn down and a large barn has been built where it stood; also a few other buildings are still standing on the place. A cornerstone with the words, T. H. Smith, 1881, Kansas City, Missouri, is under one building. The farm is owned by Ed Swandle; he lives in Sacramento, California.
