Ealum Gregory

Ealum Gregory was a stock man, he owned the Ketchum Elevator and had been president of the First State Bank of Ketchum since its establishment, about 1912. On July 12, 1934, the bank was held up and robbed by two men, an old man and a young man, said to have come from down in the Cookson hill settlement.

Gregory, his son, Milton and his son-in-law, Blackford followed the robbers in a car to a point south of Grove on Honey Creek, where they overtook.

them, sitting in front of a farmer's house, inquiring the way out of that part of the country. The Gregory's and Mr. Blackford, drove right up behind the robber's car and the elder Gregory was getting out of the car, with a shotgun in his hand, when one of the robbers shot him dead.

His son-in-law, Blackford, sitting in the back seat of the banker's car with a shotgun then shot and killed both robbers, before they could turn in their seat to fire on him.

The boy's parents, who lived near Core in Sequoyah County, came and got the body of the young man, and stated that he had been led into the crime by the elder man, said to have been in his 70's, and that the boy had never been in any trouble before. No one ever claimed the old man's body.
