Powell Family Cemetery.

It is impossible to determine just when this cemetery was founded. The fence with which it has been enclosed is down and stock have pushed down one of the two headstones. I am informed the Powells were Choctaw citizens and that it is possible that Mrs. Susan E. Powell is still living at Bokoshe. Court records show that the United Securities Company, of Kansas City, is the present owner of the property.

The Company is represented by Mr. George Corlett, state agent, at Oklahoma City. It appears that some of the changes in ownership have not been recorded and this fact accounts for the discrepancy in the statements showing present ownership.
