EDITORIAL ON TELEGRAM FROM ISPARHECHER

July 31.

Isparhecher, aged ex-chief of the Creeks, has sent the following telegram from his home in the Creek nation to United States Marshall Bennott: "Send officers to my home. I am in trouble. Do not fail." Isparhecher has recently been subjected to many indignities at the hands of the full bloods known as the Snakes who are opposing the dissolution of their tribal government, and it is believed they are harrassing the ex-chief. The full bloods seem to think that Isparhecher has deserted them. Marshall Benott has sent six deputies to the scene.
