PROCLAMATION OF ISPARHECHER

"Whereas, it has been reported to my office that certain non-citizens are engaged in the real estate business in the Muskogee nation, and that improvements are being made by them and their vendees. Therefore, I Isparhecher, principal chief of the Muskogee nation, do hereby forbid all non-citizens from attempting to erect or make any improvements whatever on the lands of this nation; and the district judges of this nation are hereby directed to tear down any improvements thus made under such pretended authority as above stated, and are further directed to prevent the making of further improvements of this character."
