NEWS ITEM OF ALEX POSEY

A recent decision of the supreme court declaring the titles given by inheritors of fullblood Indian lands to be good makes the estate of Alex Posey more valuable by several thousand dollars. Alex Posey had acquired extensive interests in such titles and his estate is now estimated to be worth between twenty-five and thirty thousand dollars. His wife and children will now be well provided for. The life insurance, payable to Mrs. Posey, amounts to \$5000.
