Okmulgee, I. T.,

Nov. 22, '87.

I, J. M. Perryman, Principal Chief of the Muskogee Nation, do hereby appoint and designate the 24th day of the present month as a day of thanksgiving, and suggest that the same be spent in such acknowledgements and signification of the gratitude of the people as shall be appropriate to the occasion.
