The payment is made by the Indian agent. George Bixby is in charge. Among those who were in the city yesterday was Legus Perryman of Tulsa. He is one of the oldest Creek citizens in the Territory. He was a resident of the Creek nation before the civil war and is one of the original loyal Creeks. From 1887 to 1895 he was chief of the Creeks. Perryman has a clear memory, a bright eye, keen intellect and is an interesting talker. -- Phoenix.
