EDITORIAL ON L. C. PERRYMAN

An extra session of the Creek council met at Okmulgee Tuesday to formulate plans for disposing of the \$200,000 paid them by the last congress. \$600,000 was the amount wanted so that they could pay off the debts of the nation and have a percapita payment also. It is now believed that the per capita payment will not be made and that the \$200,000 will be appropriated toward paying off the nations debts. A great deal of dissatisfaction exists in the creek nation in regard to the way in which the finances are used.

The chief has been accused of issuing warrants without authority and it is said the council will investigate this matter this session.
