EDITORIAL ON L. C. PERRYMAN

The dula government in the Creek nation, one headed by the suspended chief Perryman and the other by second Chief Bullet, was ended today for the time by United States Agent D. M. Wisdom, who refused to recognize Perryman as the lawful chief of the Creek nation and all citizens of said nation (Bullet) and all others will take notice and govern yourselves accordingly."

The action of Wisdom is based on the fact that the national council failed to notify him of the removal of Chief Perryman. The matter ends here until the Creek nation elect a chief in September.
