Tuesday Morning 28 Dec Pickard
Hartkins left home soon after breakfast
horse back going out to hunt up Orpa -
he was gone about one hour when his horse
was seen $\frac{1}{2}$ mile from his house towards wash
hommas seen by a boy over ^{wagon} " I got word
Thursday Evening I got word started at 6 a.m.
got there 1 or 2 A.M. in the night found Lormon
in a heap of trouble Mrs Howell & daughter and
James Hartkins & George Hartkin Jr. was there
as soon as I got there Lormon told me she suspected
Prince (Prince) next morning I started out
after the man that saw the horse and brought
him in and he showed us the place and we
tracked the horse back tracks to the rail
fence where Prince was splattering about ~~too~~ ^{too} good
back of the grave yards I left and went
with Solomon & Adam to wash homma and got
in boat and landed at Ashleys ford to hunt
for him as his horse tracks went into the
river and came out dragging the halter rail
in the mud and found a track where the horse
started on the halter rail this we compared with the
halter also where the horse went up the hill found
when Blanks fuge shooting to bushes com hard and
found it to be the same from the blanket under
his saddle this made us believe he was drowned
~~dead~~ I advised the Company and sent $\frac{1}{2}$ to the
hills & swamp and I with the others to drag
the river for 5 miles and gone up the river Saturday
Evening " and when we got up to the house
from the river near sun down we found that the
Company had found sign enough to take up

And Suspect Prince his track was found on
 a rotten Chunk and some other sign they found
 went to Suspect Prince about Sun down we took
 him out to where he was splitting rails and
 tied him up and was going to give him a
 sever whipping but he Confessed killing him and
 brought in Adam, "that day Adam was sent
 to Red River (Poland) and asked about the time
 which looked very suspicious" Prince said that Adam
 hoped him kill him and had him under the top of
 a tree also said his Aunt Lucy had been after
 him to kill his Master and tie a rock to him and
 sink him in little river and it would not be found out
 and that she would be good to him as long as she
 lived also they would then move back to Mountain fork
 and all together again" She was taken up and
 closely guarded & Adam (Saturday night) About
 midnight Prince spoke and said (no one asking
 him any thing) and said that his master Adam
 did not know any thing about it that he just said
 so" and still said that he never thought of killing his
 master while Lucy come over here to live he said that
 she had bin after him to kill him for a long time
 and a rainy day was to be the time: Prince said his
 Aunt Lucy gave him the rope to tie the rock to him
 he said the rope came around Aunt Lucy's basket
 when she come from Mountain fork and she gave it
 to him and told him how to tie it Prince says
 Richard got off his horse to help him roll over a rail
 cut and when he had his back turn'd he struck
 him with the poll of the axe between the shoulders
 and struck him two or three times after and then held
 him in the leaves in the tree top

Next morning at day light my self and James Harken
 and George Harken Jr went with Prince to find the
 body he promised to show itt we was walking along
 and Prince said that Adam did not know any
 thing about it - that it was his aunt Lucy he
 said he visited three times in packing her to the river
 he went and showed as the log he walked out on
 and throwed him on the upper side James Harken got
 a pole and soon found it to be a fact I was goring
 the boy and had a hold of the chain and was standing
 close to the edge of the river and I was thrown off
 my hand by say James Harken now Richard up
 and the boy jumped from me and jumped in the
 river and drowned him self and we could not help
 it or get him out for we tried I wanted to reach
the devil we went back to the house and after
 break fast and come and got up Richard and found
 a rock tied to him that would weigh 25 pounds tied
 to his back - also fishing up the devil River and
 here him to the bank for further Concessions and
 on arriving Richard found his mouth stuffed full of leaves
 and mud his skull broken in one of his right ear
 cut half a to from the back of the side of his head
 also a cut on his throat either one of the stone
 blocks would of killed him he was buried on Monday
 "Sunday the day he was found" also Prince drowning him self
 same day Flora was dragg'd up to whom he killed his
 master and they was both placed on a log heap and
 burnt up this is just my thing transper

 death of her husband Since Mrs Howell & daughter
 saw a white man had no show amongst half breeds
 she and her daughter never white man and that is
 what they got mixed at it
