Dear father

I will write you a few lines in  
Peter's letter. you will here of the difficulty Peter is in before  
you will receive this letter. I am sorry and trouble about  
it Peter got here yesterday tired down. I am afraid it will  
make him sick no one knows he is here but Robinson folks  
and Robert Nail family Peggy came on here with him from  
her house. Peter is lively. he talks about his wife and child  
wants to see them. James Robinson has bin here all day  
I think he better not go back soon until the excitement  
is over he will stay here until he hears from you. Loring  
is not at home he has gone down Texas some 300 miles  
from here Peter meet Loring as he was coming up.  
all of us has bin sick since we have bin here all well now  
I am pleas. with my new home the children talks  
about old bea pa wants to see there old home. Rhoda  
and Bucky talks about you. Bucky has grown good deal he  
can ride ~~fill~~ about. I have just receive a letter from  
Loring written from Hadges he will try and get back  
as soon as he could. and take Peter with us to the  
Coil Springs Peter wants to go with us. uncle Israel  
is at home. we have had no rain 5 weeks to day great many  
springs and wells gone dry. I have to stop writing most  
time for the Stage to come. in haste  
Bucky sends his love to Tomony
