Whereas we the members of the General Council of the Choctaw Nation
deem it our duty to give expression to the deep interest we feel for
the brave warriors now in defence of their Country and that we ear-
nestly desire to evince to them their long self sacrificing and
patriotic efforts in behalf of their Country & warmly apprecia-
ted by their fellow citizens and members of this Council.

Be it resolved by the General Council of the Choctaw Nation
assembled That we cordially and gratefully tender our thanks
and Congratulations to the gallant officers and unflinching
warriors of this Nation for the noble defence of their Country and
the great success that has ever attended their efforts; Speak
loudly in behalf of their zeal, patriotism and fidelity

Be it further resolved That we will use every effort to aid
and sustain them in this great struggle for liberty and nati-
onal independence and that we feel a firm and abiding reli-
ance in their cause and the means that are being used to
accomplish this great end and that by the protecting pow-
er of kind Providence we will succeed in driving the
sandal shoe from our land and Country.

Be it further resolved That the National Secretary forward a
copy of these resolutions to the Commanders of each Choctaw
Regiment and Battalion with a request that they be read
in public to the Troops.
