Sir,

As several members of the Council requested me to call your attention to a certain thing, I will drop a lines to you:

It was this: That the Council intended to bring to your notice the 1st section of the act of Confederate Congress, approved, May 1st, 1863, regulating the election of an Indian delegate ~~to~~ the amendment thereto, approved, January 5th, 1864, but they forgotten it entirely. They wanted to pass a resolution to the effect that you call an election to be held to elect a Choctaw delegate to serve one year more.

They requested that you call such election soon, so that we may have a representation at Richmond this year. &c.
