April 28. 1837

I am here at the Agency on my way home from Demopolis.

This District ~~has~~ ^{has} appointed a General Council to be held at Hushshuckeev creek about three miles from the Treaty ground that is between Mr Springs and the Treaty Ground. It will be on the 17th of May we should be proud to see you there and how you would be of essential service to us assisting in and managing business for the Council &c.

The intention of the Council is to put old Moosha Catubbe out of office and put Peter & Picketlym in

his place. I believe the people
is little uneasy in keeping the
old Chief in office. It is because
that old Mooshatattubee is losing
ground amongst his own friends
and ^{they} think it proper to dismiss
and put a new one in his
place. I think it is a very wise
plan they have fell upon.

And also the intention of the
people is to hear the Treaty explained
to them again, they say they do
not understand it wish to hear
it so they may know what to
do, and many other little things
will be done. I hope you will
be so good as to come and give
us assistance. I saw Peter Petchlyme
here and he requested me to write
you and give you a notice of
the council

My self and Peter have concluded
to give your party (that is Cole &
Perry) an invitation to our Council
and if they should come and
your self. it would be of great
advantage to you of speaking
to them about the Arkansas
River and the conversation we
had together at Mr Gains
