Dear Bro

Sir

I am sorry to say to you that one my match horse is dead one was sick at your house. I saw a communication from G. S. Gaines that he was appointed to remove the Choctaws to Mississippi River no farther and he says that you and Folsome are otherwise to assist him in removing the Choctaws I am hoping to see this appointment it will be some in my District no doubt this will give great satisfaction with the people because it is option with the people how they will go to the west. when you see the instruction you will be better judge of the movement of the Genl Geor to ward the Choctaws.
