I just
received a letter from Moke of Fort Smith

he would be to some trouble in coming up
here I offered him ten dollars - I will push
it up & Geo will come safe to hand
we were glad Geo got through safe and finding all
well - Dana got well - So has Mimi Molly
both had a hard time from Amelias Times
very well. Nothing said about the Council only
Called a beto Council - The de Chief phined
out his friends how that he ever had
and Geo's old friends come home to their
fathers habitation upon the whole
Cole being Elector is best It places Geo
on Geo's old stomping ground they are
satisfied that Old Peter is the safest old
slow trust dog in the pack and they
are willing to follow the old Peter

The Decima bill did not come up I don't
think. The Council adjourned at 12 O'Clock
after Jan left and the biggest drunken spree
I have seen since I left L'ikefatah
The old Indian Song Chenizer kept sober
William was drunk and got drunk but honey
we have had a pleasant time up to a few days
