Cor Peachlan son i drops you a few line to no
if you no envy thing a bout my Mother and Father I
was a son of William Bottom my Mother was a darter of
Mashula taba my Mother had a brother name Elaccha
he was bit by a snake and died in the old mackson
and sh had a brother name ~~yes~~ yacanana toba her
name was ann I came to the choktaw mackson with
daniel Fulsom and staid with him un till the year
1837 and we shall bant som guns from the Chocktaws
and hired me to go with ^{him} to the Cherokee mackson to sell
them and i stade that and married a Cherokee woman and
stay there un till this somer too of my sonns was
killed there thay got in a dphcsty a bout the were my
sonn was gres and thay war pines and i was theron that
they would kill me and i left and come to red river mer
soak looses the Chickasaw said that i would have
to pay twenty five dollars to live there i thant that
i would go and see som of my oal friends so i went
down to dackville and sawl my oal friends was dead
but Brazzel Flore he tol me see Jerry Ward and
he could tell me a bout my write in the Chocktan
Brazzel said to ride to you all so Jerry ward said

that he knowe my mother and her brothers he new
when elocba was snake but he say that Mashula taha
was there father but there mother a mother
woman that she was not Mashula taha wife my
mother was a half chocktaw i have seen you
a great many time when i lived at davide
fulgore i new Issie fulgore when he was
Chief of the Chocktaw and i new awl the
old people a bout doaxvill i was a 11 year
old when i come from the old nation you
please look over my scribblin and if you
can ade me enny in get in me way write
in the nation please write to me as soon as you
get this ~~as~~ plez write direc your letter to
Denton Cook County Texas Zach Bottom
i doo not want to live in Texas if i can help
and i will not live with the Cherokee enny
more
