

Report of the Choctaw Academy and Missionary
Station in Scott County Kentucky at the Blue
Springs embracing the quarters ending 31st April
and 31st of July 1826

In this report reference is made to
to the report of the 31st Jan'y last. as regards the
situations of the stations, its local advantages
buildings &c with addition of one large stone
building ^{erected this summer.} 25 feet wide and 47 feet long, adjoin-
ing and constituting a part of the former described
Academy - The whole establishment taken to-
gether makes one of the most convenient and
roomy Academies in the western country

In addition to the convenience of light
and fire places in the first buildings used
for an academy, this latter and adjoining
apartment has two large fireplaces below
and two above stairs; with 10 twenty light
windows below and 10 ^{of} twelve lights each
above stairs. It communicates with the
old academy by an opening of 8 feet.

The addition made to this academy
is sufficient to admit of ^{60 or 70} ~~an~~ additional
~~number~~ of students to the number formerly

~~Mentions~~ — or the whole establishment is
ample for the accomodation of 150 or 60
Students.

Reference is also made to the last report as regards
the conduct, improvement and general deportment of
of the Choctaw boys, ^{except that} On the first of May one by the
name of Tho Wall was added to the ~~number~~ ^{number} making
the total number now in school 27.

This last one is to be proved for out the funds are
-sing from the 52 sections of land

The whole twenty seven without exception are
in fine health well contented, comfortably provided for &
and in every respect improving beyond calculation

The flourishing condition of the institution, the
progress and flattering prospects of improvement
of the Choctaw boys have far exceeded the most
benign expectation — a list of the names and ages
of the Choctaw students are herewith forwarded.
