We have had but little ^{change} in the institution since the
last report ^{which was} made ^{out only} two months ago; therefore ~~for particulars~~
reference is ~~made~~ given ^{to that report} to the report of the inspectors, ^{and}
^{at the same time,} ~~for~~ for particulars - The principal change which has
taken place, is, the death of one of the Prairie du chien
boys and the reception of a Potawatamie, both of
which took place within a few days of the close of the
last quarter, leaving as before the ^{total} number 163 Students.

The sickness and death of the Prairie du chien boy
has been the only case of disease among the Students
of any consequence during the last quarter - Their health
at this time is remarkably good - The supplies for
boarding ^{and medical attendance} and clothing are abundant ~~and~~ of good
quality - ^{and regularly afforded} The teaching department, is conducted with
rigid attention both as to discipline and instructions,
in the different branches of literature.

The work shops ~~are~~ ^{if continued} conducted under prudent and

and judicious arrangements will turn out a number
of first rate mechanics for each of the tribes.

Religious exercises are constantly observed and the
moral conduct of the students rigidly watched over.
