— Eagletown C. N. June 29<sup>th</sup> 1841

Dear Sir, I will just write a few lines to inform you that on Saturday 19<sup>th</sup> inst you was appointed Captain, vice Fisher Mingo deceased.

Capt. Solomon made a speech informing all present of the appointment, (it was at the old Capt. cry) & approving of it. Capt. Shoni followed — all appeared to be well pleased with your appointment. Israel Folsom & Anukhobela are your right & left hand men, & will attend to the business of the company while you are absent. Anukhobela has gone to Israel Folsoms to arrange matters with him & get a list of of of our company who are living in that section of country.

Capt Hudson has appointed tomorrow for the Mountain Fork Captains to meet at this place to register their companies — Anukhobela will be at home this evening & we will make out our list tomorrow we are all well — so are all our friends so far as I know,

enclosed you have a letter from your family which will give you the family news &c

~~The~~ Crops look well so far, & if it the season continues as good through the summer as it has been there will be fine crops made about here
